Proposed Action or Project Description:

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act:

The Native Village of Afognak of Alaska proposes to 1) conduct a comprehensive energy audit of a newly purchased Tribal Office Building; 2) conduct a comprehensive energy audit of a Youth Camp Facility; 3) conduct building retrofits to the Tribal Office Building which includes—replacement/upgrade of control valves, in-core monitoring devices, facility air filtration systems, programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, lighting retrofits, insulation, HVAC replacements with similar equipment, weather-stripping/caulking, replacement of appliances with EE appliances, and install energy efficient curtains to reduce heat loss on the window/glass doors; and 4) conduct the same building retrofits identified in Activity 3 (Tribal Office Building) to the Youth Camp Facility.
