Proposed Action or Project Description:

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act:

1) Hire consultant to update city's energy efficiency and conservation strategy plan and development of air quality and traffic analysis; 2) adopt California green building code, train reviewers, inform public and builders; 3) replace air conditioning units at Grand Avenue Park Building, McCoy Equestrian Center Building, McCoy Equestrian Center and install tracking/management software for new units; 4) replace illuminated street signs with reflector signs; and 5) replace lighting at McCoy Equestrian Center, Grand Avenue Park, Government Center Parking Structure, and Government Center building/grounds, and Boys Republic and Shoppes Drive.

Conditions: None—must meet requirements as stated in Programmatic Agreement document
