Proposed Action or Project Description: American Recovery and Reinvestment Act:

1) Replace water well motor pumps at Well 14, 20, 21, and 22 and conduct air conditioner retrofits at the East Side Fire Station (1945) and the Community Development Building (1945); 2) replace windows in fire stations located at 132 West 11th Avenue (1984) and East Side Fire Station at 1001 12th Avenue (1945), Civic Center (1978), Community Development Building (1945), National Guard Armory (1970), Waste Water Treatment Plant (1979), Police Annex (2007), VFW Hall (1970), City Corp Yard (1977), and Former Transit Building (1983); and 3) engineering/ architectural services and installation of cool roofs on two fire houses located at 132 W 11th Avenue (1984) and East Side Fire Station at 1001 12th Avenue (1945), Community Development Building (1945), and Civic Center (1978) which includes removal/replacement of ceramic/concrete tile roof, replacement of batten system, and installation of shingle cool roofs.

Conditions: Historic preservation clause applies to this application--SHPO consultation and approval required
