1) Conduct lighting retrofits in city buildings (City Hall, Council Chambers, Community Center/Senior Center, and Rose Center) which includes replacing some existing fluorescent fixtures with T8 lamps and low-watt electronic ballasts, replacing some 1st generation T8 fluorescent fixtures with T8 lamps and low-watt electronic ballasts, replacing some incandescent fixtures with compact fluorescent lamps or new PL-lamp fixtures, and adding occupancy sensor controls and daylight controls to interior lighting fixtures in some of the facilities; 2) replace tennis court light fixtures at Park West and Bolsa Chica Park; 3) furnish and install LED traffic signal indicator lights at intersections and furnish and install LED illuminated street name retrofit kits at intersections; 4) install chiller at Rose Center; and 5) retrofit lamps and ballasts of bus shelter advertising panels and bus shelter area lighting.
