Proposed Action or Project Description: American Recovery and Reinvestment Act:

1) Conduct energy audits at 15 primary facilities; 2) purchase hybrid vehicles for fleet replacement; 3) develop new walking/biking pathways; 4) replace LED streetlights; 5) recreation field lighting upgrade; 6) solar photovoltaic installation at Fire Station; and 7) city building retrofits—demand control ventilation device and HVAC replacement at Center for Arts Performing Arts Theater; air chiller system replace at Coral Springs Gymnasium; covert flag lighting to LED; install lighting fixtures, motion sensor switches, HVAC repairs/upgrades; windows/door/roofing insulation improvements at theater and/or gymnasium; and replace high-flow water fixtures with low-flow fixtures to achieve energy savings in city buildings.

Conditions: None—must meet requirements as stated in Programmatic Agreement document for historic facilities

Categorical Exclusion(s) Applied: A1, A11, B1.32, B2.5, B5.1
