Proposed Action or Project Description:

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act:

This project is to retrofit Village Hall lighting in accordance with plans developed through the lighting design and engineering plans prepared under separate project funded through EECBG. The improvements described in the engineering documents include replacing the existing lighting fixtures with energy efficient fixtures and associated equipment, including motion sensors. The lighting replacement will include all areas of the building consisting of common areas, offices, conference rooms, Council Chambers and lower level Police Station. This project will fund a portion of the costs associated with the retrofit, including materials and labor. The balance of the project will be funded with local non-federal resources.
