American Recovery and Reinvestment Act:

1) Hire consultant to develop energy efficiency and conservation strategy, 2) energy efficiency upgrades at 4 city buildings (e.g., replacement of air-cooled condensers, heating boiler system, roofs, and cooling tower systems), 3) install fiber optic cable and CCTV cameras, 4) bike trails, 5) develop new building codes and construct table-top model of downtown Overland Park area, 6) install LED street lights, and 7) one-year membership to International Council for Local Environmental Initiatives - Local Governments for Sustainability to utilize greenhouse gas inventory software.
