Proposed Action or Project Description: American Recovery and Reinvestment Act:

1) Technical assistance to develop the Strategic Energy Sustainability Strategy/Plan, 2) residential financial assistance program for energy efficiency projects, 3) window retrofit at Headquarters Fire Station, 4) replace roof and HVAC at Community Outreach Center, 5) replace City Hall roof, 6) replace Police Department roof, 7) replace Police Department HVAC, 8) lighting retrofit at City Hall, 9) HVAC retrofit at Municipal Operations Center, 10) replace Municipal Operations Center roof, 11) energy information and communications program, 12) install solar panels at 13 fire stations, 13) lighting retrofit at the Municipal Operations Center, 14) replace HVAC and roof at Kivett Municipal Operations Center, 15) replace windows and doors at Safe Haven Community Outreach Center, 16) replace heating system at Fleet Services Building, 17) replace roof at Recreation Maintenance Building (Oak Hollow), and 18) replace roof at Radio Building (1944).

Conditions: SHPO approval for some projects dated 3/12/2010; roof replacement at Radio Building must be in accordance with Programmatic Agreement

Categorical Exclusion(s) Applied: A1, A9, A11, B2.5, B5.1
