Proposed Action or Project Description:

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act:

1) Hire a Project Administrator to oversee energy efficiency and conservation grant and administrative costs associated with application; 2) develop an energy efficiency and conservation strategy and a comprehensive plan to provide long-term guidance for energy efficiency improvements; 3) install a roof-mounted, approximately 165 kW, photovoltaic solar energy system with UPS battery backup on Edison Municipal Complex; 4) perform energy efficiency lighting retrofits and lighting controls, roof-mounted HVAC replacements, electronic fuel-use economizers for air conditioning and force hot air heating and related HVAC controls at the Minnie E. Veal Community Center (1989); 5) install a roof-mounted solar thermal system for hot water on the Edison Municipal Animal Shelter (1985); 6) purchase and install studio lighting and perform roof renovations at the Edison Community Access TV Station; and 7) replace the municipal area network virtual servers.
