American Recovery and Reinvestment Act:

1-8) Replace heating, ventilating, and air conditioning (HVAC) systems in the following county-owned facilities with more energy efficient systems: (1) Department of Public Works Building (1990); (2) Heckle Boulevard Government Complex (1985-1987); (3) Health Department Building (1963); (4) EC Black Building (1986); (5) Scale House (1995); (6) Transfer Station (1994); (7) Department of Social Services Building (1974); (8) York County Courthouse (1914, listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1981); 9) replace HVAC system at the Fort Mill Leroy Springs Recreation Center; 10) replace 48 metal halide lamp fixtures with more energy efficient fixtures at the Fort Mill Leroy Springs Recreation Center, an NGO-owned facility; 11) distribute an energy efficiency and recycling package to residents as part of an education program designed to increase participation in the county recycling program; 12) conduct an energy audit at the Moss Justice Center (1989); and 13) upgrade lighting, replace lamps, ballasts, and fixtures at the Moss Justice Center (1989).

Conditions: Historic preservation clause applies to this application (York County Courthouse [1914 NRHP 1981])
