Proposed Action or Project Description: American Recovery and Reinvestment Act:

1) Development of an energy efficiency and conservation strategy (completed); 2) acquisition of technical services to perform audits and install roof-mounted solar photovoltaic (approximately 60 kW) on City Hall (1986) and Fire Station 2 (2004); 3) acquisition of technical services to perform water audits of municipal facilities; 4) development and implementation of a water conservation education and outreach program; 5) replacement of windows in City Hall (1986) with more energy efficient units; 6) acquisition of technical services to develop a feasibility assessment of the proposed energy efficiency infrastructure improvements for use of non-potable water for irrigation of the sports fields at the McInnish Sports Complex; 7) completion of timing coordination for city traffic signals; 8) completion of the retrofit of traffic signals with LED lamps; 9) LED lighting retrofits for parking lots at the City Hall complex at 1945/2001 E Jackson Road and the two Pump Stations at 2150 Old Denton Road and 4750 N Josey Lane and 10) hire grant coordinator.
