Proposed Action or Project Description:

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act:

1) Develop energy efficiency and conservation strategy; 2) construct bike/pedestrian pathway in accordance with revised design and layout which avoids impacts to the floodplain; and 3) lighting upgrades at Mayborn Convention Center (1982); building envelope improvements which includes sealing air leaks at City Hall (1928); implement recycling policy for city offices which includes purchasing recycling containers; installing programmable thermostats in city facilities; installing window film at Mayborn Convention Center and Fire Stations #2 and #4; install attic spray insulation at Fire Stations #2, #4, and #7; install occupancy sensors at City Animal Shelter and City Hall; install flag pole lighting at various locations throughout the city; and install an HVAC unit at Fire Station #6.
