

#### **PROJECT DATA**

- Layout: 3 bdrm, 2 bath, 1 fl, 1,437 ft<sup>2</sup>
- Climate: IECC 2A, hot-humid
- Completed: May 2017
- Category: affordable

### **KEY FEATURES**

- Walls: Concrete block wall, <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" EPS foam board on interior, <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" furring strips, perforated foil insulation, <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" gypsum board, stucco cladding.
- **Roof:** 5%" sheathing; self-adhering underlayment; ENERGY STAR reflective asphalt shingles. Borate-treated 2x8" soffit and roof trusses.
- Attic: Unvented; insulated under roof deck with 5.5" R-20 water-based spray foam.

- Foundation: Slab on grade; uninsulated; framing treated for termites.
- Windows: Double-pane, single-hung, low-e, argon-filled, thermally insulated, vinyl frames; U=0.32, SHGC=0.19.
- Air Sealing: 3.15 ACH 50
- Ventilation: Controlled central fan with fresh air intake and timered exhaust.
- HVAC: Ducted mini-split heat pump, 1.5 ton, 15.5 SEER.
- Hot Water: Hybrid 50-gallon hot water heater, 2.35 EF.
- Lighting: 100% LED, ENERGY STAR ceiling fans.
- **Appliances:** ENERGY STAR refrigerator and dishwasher.
- Solar: None.
- Water Conservation: Meets Florida Water Star guidelines, low-flow toilets, shower heads, and faucets; drought-resistant landscape, no irrigation.
- Energy Management System: Standard thermostat.
- **Other:** No-VOC paint. CARB ATCM emission standard-compliant countertops. Florida Friendly Landscaping compliant. Wind-resistant design. Stucco treated for termites.
