- Layout: 3 bdrm, 2 bath, 1 fl, 1,464 ft<sup>2</sup>
- Climate: IECC 2A, hot-humid
- Completed: June 2019
- Category: Affordable

### **KEY FEATURES**

- Walls: CMU, R-11 total: concrete masonry unit blocks, <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" EPS foam board on interior face of wall topped by <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" furring strips, perforated foil-craft insulating sheet and <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" gypsum board. Liquid-flashing at windows. Stucco siding.
- **Roof:** Truss hip roof: 5/8" sheathing, self-adhered membrane over whole deck, asphalt shingles. ENERGY STAR Cool Roof certified. Borate-treated trusses and roof framing.
- HERS Index: without PV 44
- Annual Energy Costs: without PV \$850
- Annual Energy Cost Savings: (vs typical new homes) without PV \$700
- **Annual Energy Savings:** without PV 5,800 kWh
- Savings in the First 30 Years: without PV \$28,800

- Attic: Sealed attic: 5.5" R-20 open-cell spray foam on underside of roof deck, on knee wall between garage and living space.
- Foundation: Slab on grade, no insulation.
- Windows: Double-pane, argon-filled, low-e, vinyl single-hung frames, U=0.32, SHGC=0.19.
- Air Sealing: 1.7 ACH 50.
- Ventilation: Controlled fresh air intake, timed bath exhaust. MERV 8 filter. Dehumidifier.
- HVAC: Ducted mini-split heat pump, 9.50 HSPF, 17.5 SEER, 1 indoor air handler, 1 outdoor condenser.
- Hot Water: Heat pump water heater, 2.35 EF, 50-gal. PEX plumbing, hot pipe insulated.
- Lighting: 100% LED.
- Appliances: ENERGY STAR refrigerator and dishwasher.
- Solar: No PV. Solar ready with panel space, conduit to roof.
- Water Conservation: EPA WaterSense fixtures. Drought resistant, native landscaping.
- Energy Management System: Energy, PV, temp, humid. monitors; Wi-Fi thermostats.
- Other: Zero-VOC paint. 160-mph wind-resistant hip roof.
