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

Latest EAct 2005 Section 701 Waivers Now Available on TransAtlas

The locations of the most recent Energy Policy Act (EAct) of 2005 Section 701 waived vehicles are now posted online and can be viewed in TransAtlas. TransAtlas is an interactive map that users can customize to display, query, download, and print underlying data.

To use the new TransAtlas feature, visit <http://maps.nrel.gov/transatlas> and scroll to the "701 Waived Fleets" drop-down menu. This list will populate with each Federal agency that received waivers. Simply select the agency of interest and TransAtlas will populate the map with waived vehicle locations. When the map populates, right click on the selected agency to view the legend for that layer. To view information for an individual fleet location, select "Query" from directly above the map view, then select the "By Point" option. By clicking on a particular fleet location, users can view the unit name, address, and number of waived vehicles. Please note that if multiple agencies are selected, users need to choose an agency from the "Select Layer to Query" pop-up.



Please note: TransAtlas does not function well in Microsoft Internet Explorer (IE), especially if a user is running an older version of IE (for example, older than IE version 7), and it may cause that browser to crash. It is recommended that users access the tool via Mozilla Firefox or Google Chrome. Please consult your IT personnel for questions about these Internet browsers. Fleet Management Frequently Asked Questions Available Online

The new FEMP frequently asked questions (FAQ) database is designed to help Federal agencies find answers to questions about all aspects of fleet management. Available online at www1.eere.energy.gov/eere_faq/default.aspx?pid=3&spid=1, these FAQs can help educate fleet

managers on alternative fuels, and help them learn how to overcome barriers, find tools and resources, and much more.

Greenhouse Gas Inventories due January 31

Federal agencies must submit their greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions inventories by January 31, 2011. The inventories must be entered into the FEMP reporting portal, which is a Microsoft Excel workbook that can be found online at www.fedcenter.gov/programs/greenhouse/inventoryreporting/. The transportation-related data captured in the reporting portal includes:

- Federal Automotive Statistical Tool (FAST) annual reporting
- Vehicles and equipment not captured in FAST
- Business travel (both air and ground travel)
- Commuting.

FEMP, the Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ), and the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) worked together to alleviate reporting requirements as much as possible. The reporting portal also integrates data from FAST. FEMP First Thursday Seminar—Federal Fleet Management 101

FEMP kicks off the 2011 series of First Thursday Seminars on February 3 with the Federal Fleet Management 101 seminar, which is recommended for all levels of Federal fleet managers. The seminar can help you comply with Executive Order (E.O.) 13514 and other Federal fleet mandates through best practices that reduce GHG emissions and petroleum consumption by increasing alternative fuel use and fleet fuel efficiency. In the seminar you'll learn how to:

- Identify the best strategies for reducing vehicle miles traveled, increasing fuel economy, and acquiring alternative fuel and plug-in hybrid vehicles
- Comply with GHG and petroleum reduction data reporting requirements related to Federal fleets
- Right-size and optimize the composition of your agency's vehicle fleet.

Reminder: Annual Fleet Compliance Reports due February 15

Federal agencies are required to provide Congress with an annual written compliance report on fleet management for the previous fiscal year. Using data collected at the beginning of each fiscal year in FAST, each agency must submit an annual report describing its compliance with Federal fleet requirements within E.P.A. 1992 and 2005 mandates as well as progress made toward the fuel consumption goals outlined in E.O. 13423. Each year, a hard copy of the report must be published on a publicly accessible Web site by February 15 and provided to Congress. Fleet managers must also send the Web site link of their report to the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) via federal_fleets@ee.doe.gov for publication on the FEMP Web site at www.femp.energy.gov/regulations/fleet_reports.html. This link must be sent to DOE by the end of February each year.
