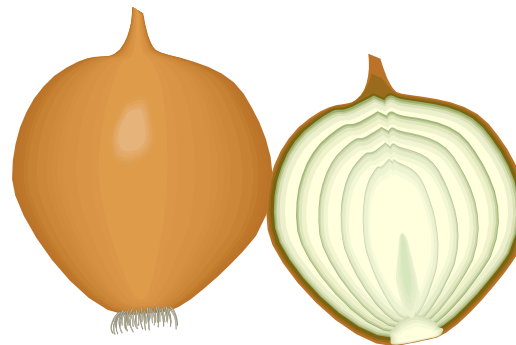

  - Numeric scores and meaningful supporting comments
- *And...* WIIFM
  - “Free” expert advice for Principal Investigators
  - Identification of potentially useful new technologies, applicable lessons learned and collaboration opportunities for Reviewers
  - An improved set of project outcomes: identification of wins; and a more robust community of engineers, project managers and scientists
