

State and local governments, Indian tribes, and overseas U.S. territories may apply to receive technical assistance from NREL for understanding and deploying energy efficiency and renewable energy technologies.

Technical Assistance Includes:

- Project Assistance – renewable energy siting, green buildings, technical assessments, and measurement & evaluation
- Program Design – energy efficiency and renewable energy assessments and portfolio design, sustainable community design, and assistance with reducing international barriers
- Contract Assistance – technical specifications development for requests for proposals (RFPs) and performance contracting
- Financing Policies and Programs – design and structure of revolving loan funds, loan loss reserves, credit mechanisms, and leveraging private investments
- Planning – strategic planning, energy management, building codes, project screening, and cost & capacity factors
- Policy Analysis – local, state, federal, and financial
- Skills Development – trainings, workshops, peer matching, and webinars

The expert technical assistance team includes both NREL experts and a network of partners including other DOE laboratories, including Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory, Oak Ridge National Laboratory, and Pacific Northwest National Laboratory.
